To whom it may concern:

This declaration is to inform Customers of Richardson Metals that extrusions produced by Richardson Metals contain trace amounts of chemicals listed on California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act 0f 1986. This Act, commonly known as Proposition 65, establishes a list of chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.

Chemical exposure typically occurs through inhalation, ingestion, and/or absorption. Our extrusions are not intended to be eaten or inhaled and will not absorb through the skin under normal conditions. Unfortunately, Richardson Metals cannot foresee all the ways our extrusions may be used (both intended and unintended) and to what extent this may create an exposure risk. Richardson Metals has chosen to provide a warning based on its knowledge about the presence of one or more listed chemicals without attempting to evaluate the level of exposure. Extrusions sold by Richardson Metals may contain listed chemicals at levels that are below the Proposition 65 level of concern, or could even be zero.
